

PROCEEDINGS OF THE CORALVILLE CITIZENS COMMUNITY POLICING ADVISORY BOARD, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF SAID BOARD AT A SUBSEQUENT MEETING

An initial and organizational meeting of the Coralville Citizens Community Policing Board was held at City Hall, 1512 7th Street on Tuesday, June 15, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM.

The following Board Members were present: Hotsenpiller, Leytem, Rivera, Slade, Ukah, Morales, Dolezal

The following City Staff were present: City Attorney Kevin Olson; Police Chief Shane Kron

Motion by Hotsenpiller, seconded by Morales to approve the agenda. Ayes: 7- Motion carried.

1. Introduction of Board Members and City Staff.
2. Explanation of Open Meetings Law by Attorney Olson- CCCPAB meetings are open to the public and Board Members should refrain from discussing topics of substance among themselves or outside of the scheduled meeting.
3. City Attorney Olsen explained the Prevailing Ordinance and the requirements of the Board and its purview.
  - a. Chief Kron answered questions about available data and the June of 2022 expected traffic stop data study report.
  - b. Board Members discussed potential training opportunities, both for themselves and recommendations for police officers.
  - c. The Board is expected to elect a Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson at their next meeting
  - d. Potential future meeting topics were discussed by Board Members and staff.
4. Future Board meeting frequency/dates were discussed. Chief Kron was directed to solicit Board Member's availability for the next meeting. Members agreed having all members present for the next meeting was desirable and that establishing a regular meeting cycle would be a goal during the next meeting.
