Individuals serving on Boards/Commissions play an important role in advising the Council, Mayor and/or Staff on matters of interest to our community and its future. Applicants must reside in Coralville, with the exception of a limited number of appointees to the Coralville Arts Commission, Library Board of Trustees, and Citizen's Community Policing Advisory Board.

The Mayor announces Advisory Board/Commission vacancies at least 30 days prior to the date the appointment will be made. This period provides for an advertising period and a possible training period for new members. The training period allows new members to become familiar with the responsibilities and duties of the advisory board/commission before becoming a full voting member.

After a vacancy has been announced and the advertising period has expired, the Mayor reviews all applications and makes recommendations to the Council. The appointment is announced at a formal Council meeting and requires Council approval. Appointees serve as unpaid volunteers.

Any current resident of Coralville is eligible and encouraged to apply. Diversity, equity, and inclusion will be considered as applications are reviewed.
