

Fares

Use exact fare; drivers do not make change.
Refunds are not available for any passes or fares.

Adults	\$1.00
Youth (5 to 18 years old)	\$0.50
Children under 5 years old.....	FREE

Must be accompanied by an adult.

Passes

All passes are mutually honored by Coralville Transit and Iowa City Transit, as long as you purchase your pass in the community where you live.

General Passes

24 hour pass.....	\$2.00
10-Ride Pass.....	\$8.50

Valid for 10 one-way rides.

Youth 31-Day Pass*	\$16.00
31-Day Pass*	\$32.00

*Valid for unlimited rides in a 31-day period from the first time it is used.

Senior & Disabled Passes

Senior (65 & over) & Disabled Pass.....FREE
Coralville residents only. A special pass is required; please call 319.248.1790 for more information.

Visitors (65 & older) & disabled persons without an eligible Senior/Disabled Pass

Please contact Coralville Transit at 319.248.1790 for a temporary pass.

Medicare cardholders and passengers with Senior and Disabled passes from other transit systems are eligible for a free ride. The pass or Medicare card must be presented upon boarding.

Transfers

Free transfers are available to Iowa City Transit buses and eligible Coralville Transit buses. Request a transfer when paying the fare.

Transfers are available when you need to use two routes to reach your destination. They cannot be issued or used on the same Coralville Transit route. They are issued to continue a one-way trip, not a return trip.

ADA Para-Transit

Coralville Transit contracts with Johnson County SEATS to provide para-transit service to eligible Coralville and North Liberty residents with disabilities who are unable to use fixed route service. Coralville ADA paratransit service operates with comparable hours to Coralville Transit's fixed-route bus service. Reasonable Modification Policy

Coralville Transit is committed to providing safe, reliable, courteous, and accessible services to our customers. To ensure equality and fairness, Coralville Transit makes reasonable modifications to its policies, practices, and procedures to avoid discrimination and to ensure programs and services are accessible to individuals with disabilities. Upon request, vacate seats labeled as reserved for elderly or those with disabilities if you are able to do so.

ADA Information

All routes are open to the general public including persons with disabilities. Relay Iowa 711 (national three-digit number for relay access) is for individuals who are deaf, hard of hearing, deaf-blind, or have difficulty speaking on the phone. Schedule & Time

Coralville Transit uses the time shown on the Weather Channel (Atomic Clock). Call 319.248.1790 to check the time if needed.

Drivers make every effort to operate on schedule; however, variations can occur. Weather, traffic, and special events may alter service. We recommended you be at your stop 5 minutes prior to the scheduled arrival.

Transit App

To follow the exact location of a bus and forecast its arrival at a bus stop:



- **Phone:** Call 319.471.4155 and enter the stop number.
- **Text:** Text 'bongo [bus stop number]' to 41411 (texting fees may apply)
- **Web:** Visit www.bongo.org
- **Mobile App:** Download the Transit app to track your bus in real-time, see expected arrival times, and enable push notifications to receive important information. Available for iPhone and Android.

Coralville Intermodal Facility

Boarding, Riding & Exiting

Drivers only stop at designated intersections and locations marked by a bus stop sign. Please have exact fare, ticket, or pass ready.

- Do not stand in the street
- Wait by bus stop signs or designated intersections
- Be respectful of others: do not smoke at the bus stop
- Signal the driver to stop the bus
- Ask for transfers as you board the bus
- Request 24 hour passes and Youth Fare before inserting money into the fare box
- Move to the rear of the bus after paying the fare
- When walking on a moving bus, hold on to stanchions or seat backs
- Be seated if seats are available
- Give the driver ample notice when you want to get off the bus
- When exiting, please use the rear doors
- Do not cross in front of the bus when leaving
- Wait until the bus leaves the stop to cross the street

For Your Safety & Comfort

Coralville Transit strives to maintain a safe, comfortable, clean, and pleasant environment for all passengers. Please note the following restrictions:

- No smoking (this includes all e-cigarettes)
- No littering
- No open containers of alcoholic beverages
- No throwing objects from a bus window or door
- No pets, unless confined to a carrier held by the passenger. *Service animals are exempt.*
- No interfering with the driver's operation of the bus
- No behavior which causes unreasonable distress to a passenger or driver
- Persons without shirts or shoes are not allowed to ride the bus
- Small children must remain seated or stand in place while the bus is moving
- Passengers are limited to carryon items that can be contained in their personal space
- Keep all aisles and emergency exits clear of personal belongings
- You must secure all mobility devices
- You must remove children from strollers and collapse strollers before boarding
- Limit use of cell phones and other electronic devices which may cause distress to the driver or other passengers

Persons violating these policies will be asked to leave the bus or prohibited from boarding.

Coral Ridge Mall Bus Stop

The bus stop for Coral Ridge Mall (stop #4220) is near the entrance to the movie theaters on the south side of the mall near the east end.

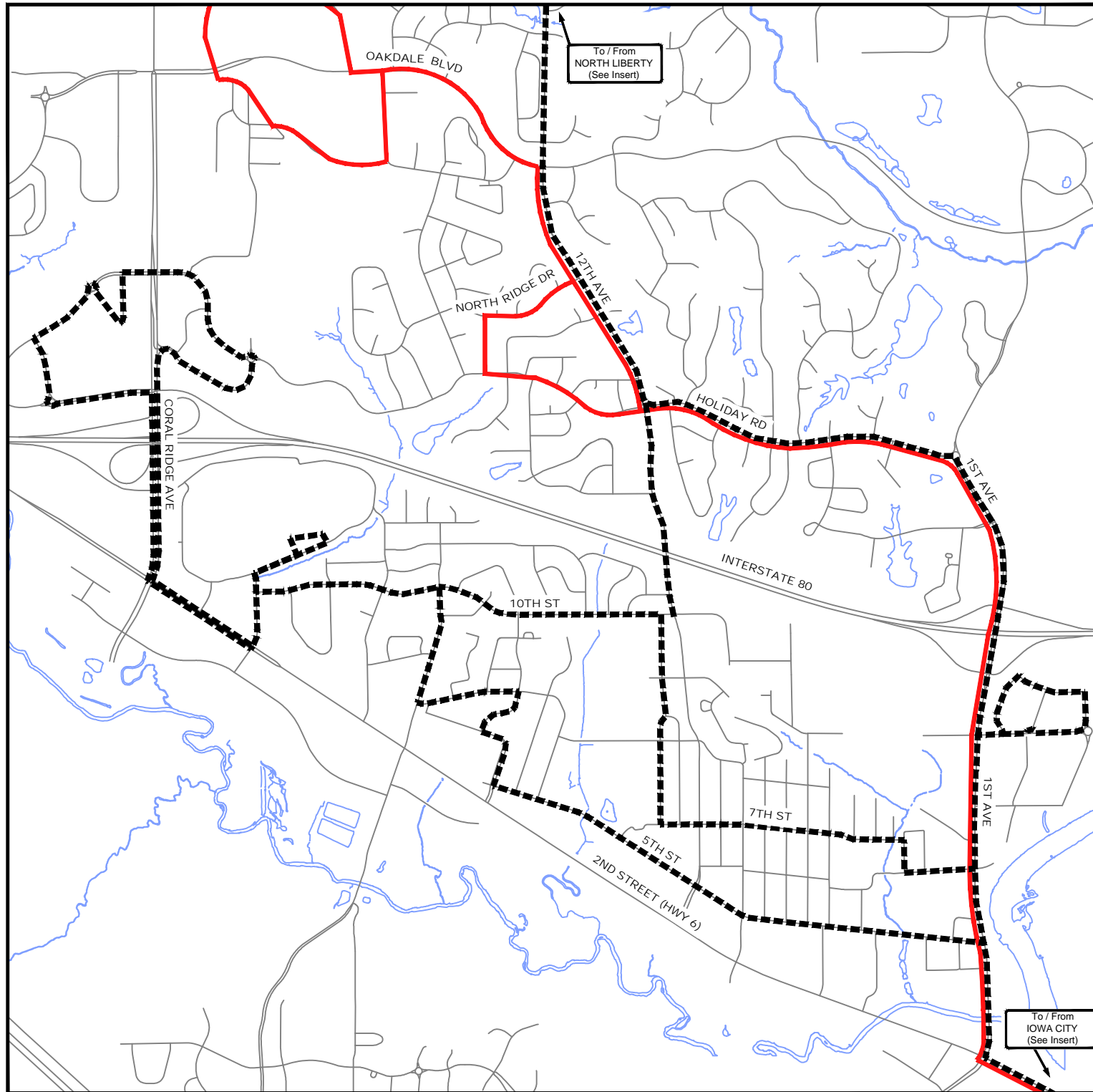

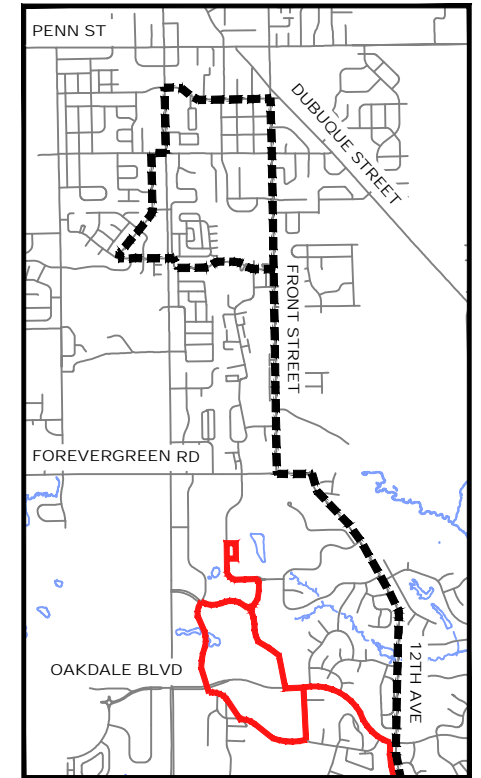
